III. <u>Authorize the Transfer of Five (5) Authorized Positions (TO) from Huey P. Long</u> <u>Hospital to the Paul M. Hebert Law Center</u>

The Louisiana State University System is requesting the approval of the transfer of five (5) authorized positions from the Huey P. Long Hospital to the Paul M. Hebert Law Center. This transfer was approved by the Board of Supervisors of Louisiana State University on March 18, 2013.

The Appropriations Act of the 2012 Regular Session authorizes the transfer of positions between higher education budget units, but requires the Board of Regents to approve any such actions. Once approved by the Board of Regents, the Division of Administration and the Joint Legislative Committee on the Budget are notified of the action.

The LSU Paul M. Hebert Law Center is currently advertising to fill one position in the library and to also hire an academic support counselor. Other positions anticipated include a vacant administrative assistant in the legal and research writing section and a counselor position in Career Services. The Law Center is currently at its total authorized table of organization.

Huey P. Long Hospital is amenable to the transfer of the needed T.O. positions for the Law Center.

Senior Staff recommends approval of the requested transfer.
