III. Preliminary FY 2014-15 Formula Funding Request

Consideration of this item serves as the Board of Regents' Budget Request for FY 2014-15 using the formula cost calculations. This is the first step in the FY 2014-15 budget cycle.

Non-formula units like the boards, and specialized institutions submit a separate request package to the Division of Administration. These requests are used by the administration to formulate the Governor's Executive Budget.

We will present a summary of funding requests for all institutions and units within Higher Education.

IV. Consideration of BA-7 for Southern University Law Center

Southern University Law Center is requesting approval of a BA-7 in the amount of \$511,675. This will allow the institution to carry-forward fees and self-generated revenue earned during FY 12/13 into FY 13/14. The GRAD Act authorized the institutions to carry-forward unexpended funds, but approval by the Joint Legislative Committee on the Budget is also required.

Staff recommends approval of this BA-7.
